1. Click on parents: [Oxford Owl for Home](#)- Free resources to support learning at home.
2. Next click on [Enter site](#) - This will take you to a screen to select the age range of your child eg. [3-4](#) or [5-6](#) etc up to [10-11](#). There are many activities for Early Years and KS1 and KS2 children.
3. If you check the icons at the top of the page you can access: [Reading, English, Maths, At school, Books and Kids activities](#).
4. To access phonics:
Click on [Books](#) icon at the top of the page:
Then scroll down the page to you see [phonics](#).

Then click on [Read Write Inc support](#) which will explain to you all about the phonics scheme.

Next right click on [Read Write Inc. Phonics](#). This will take you to a list with the different stages of learning.

Learning set 1 speed sounds: Suitable for Nursery children/Small group of reception children.

Learning set 2 speed sounds: Reception class and some Year 1 children.

Learning set 3 speed sounds: Year 1 and some Year 2 children.

Once you right click on the speed sounds you want a list of lots of resources related to the sounds you can use will show so just click on the link you want to see.

These include:

- Ditty sheets
- Speedy Green Words slideshows
- My Set 1,2,3 Speed Sounds Book as an eBook

There are daily teaching video lessons on Youtube.

Just type in [Read Write Inc phonics](#) and look for the letter set you need. There are videos for hand writing practise and saying the letter sounds.

5. **Kids activities:** Has story telling videos by Julia Donaldson which are really good. Children in Early Years and Year 1 will be familiar with her books.

6. **Maths:** has a good range of activities which covers many mathematical concepts for all year groups.
