### MATHS

This term, the class will be learning a variety of mathematical skills and knowledge some of these will be.

- Algebra** which will introduce the use of symbols to represent unknown numbers.
- Calculations of all four operations** choosing the most efficient mental strategies.
- Statistics** - exploring the order of operation using of BODMAS.
- Mean**. Introduce the mean as an average., finding the mean of the set of data.
- **Fractions**. Mixed number and improper fractions and converting from one form to another.




### MUSIC

**Songs from around the world** -Traditional songs from around the world  
**Focus on Christmas Celebrations-** Awareness of musical phrases and expression and how dynamics enhance the songs.

### SCIENCE

This term our topic will be **properties and changing material**. We will ask questions which will be answered by planning and conducting a fair test. We will record our results and draw conclusions from our results. We will explore how a chemical reaction can change a material and whether it is reversible or not.




### WRITING AND READING

Throughout this term we will be reading the 'War Games' which is set in the First World War to inspire our reading and writing. After this we will study '**The Highwayman**' by Sir Alfred Noyes which is a classic text.

**Imaginative text-** we will use a range of descriptive features to end the story.

**Wanted poster-** We will be create interpreting the text.

**Diary entry-** we will use drama to take on the role of a character. We will then write diary entries in role.



### RELIGIOUS EDUCATION

In RE we will be learning about **Justice and God's Covenant**. We will begin the topic learning about the prophets and their message and their covenant with God. We will be studying the meaning of Justice and those who have been persecuted for speaking out about injustice in the world.

We will also be learning about other faiths, particularly **JUDAISM**.



### COMPUTING

Computing this term will be closely linked to our topic work. Children will learn how best to use a computer for research purposes and how to find trustworthy information and to take notes. We will also creating our own stories using a specialised programme.

### HISTORY - GEOGRAPHY

Our topic this half term is '**BATTLE OF BRITAIN**. We will be looking at the causes and effects of the war, Evacuees, rationing, the Blitz and comparing it to World War 1 and the cause and consequences.
